The new Jasper Engines and Transmission hot air balloon will make debut at the 2010 Kentucky Derby Festival Great Balloon race in Louisville Kentucky. The Great Balloon Race will take place on April at the Kentucky State Fair Grounds. Nearly 50 balloons will take part in the event, which is part of the Derby Festival events that lead up to the running of the Kentucky Derby the first leg of the Triple Crown.
